SPRING TIME

Most of us ride all year, and then some only part of the year, starting in the spring. Well this is for everyone! The check list of what should be done before going on a ride.

1. Check engine oil and filter, change them if needed. 12. Carry a map book and cell phone.

2. Check air filter, clean or replace.

3. Check primary fluid, add if needed, and adjust primary chain if needed also.

4. Check clutch and adjustment.

5. Check transmission fluid.

6. Check brake pad, and fluids.

7. Check head light, tail light, and signals.

8. Check battery, and spark plugs.

9. Check brake and clutch cables.

10. Check tires, and air pressure.

11. Always start off with a full tank of gas
