February 10th - 6pm

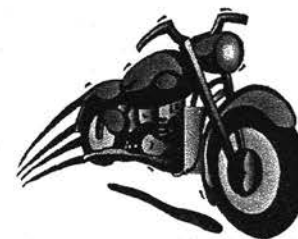
March 9th - 6pm

It's that time again to renew your annual El Cajon HOG Chapter membership. Membership forms for 2004 can be found on the website (elcajonhog.com), in this newsletter and at the dealership. Dues for 2004 are \$15.00. Remember, your National HOG dues must be current for us to issue you a local HOG membership. So check your National HOG card and keep it current.

Membership may be paid at the dealership or at one of our meetings or events. To make things easier this year, starting January 2nd, Stan has agreed to let us put your membership cards at the service counter for pickup. After we have processed your membership form I will put your card at the desk. You may stop by any time the store is open and pick it up. I will also have them at our meetings and events.


Oh yes, speaking of membership cards. On open events you will now be asked to show your El Cajon HOG membership card. If you don't have it we will ask you to complete a release form. This form will be required of everyone not a member of EC HOG and for all minors regardless of membership status. If you have a passenger that rides with you frequently make sure they sign your membership form on the "associate's signature" line. I will keep it on file so they don't have to repeat it each ride. If your partner has their own bike the best bet would be for them to join National HOG as a full (\$40) or an associate member (\$20), then join El Cajon HOG (\$15). When you join our HOG Chapter and fill out the Chapter Membership Enrollment Form and Release you are also signing a General Release which is kept in our records for that year. A new one is required to be completed every year.

Also, if your spouse or girlfriend is interested in LOH make sure her name and a contact number is listed so that I can pass the information on to Vicki, our LOH Officer.

This is going to be a great year. Remember to keep the shiny side up, the rubber side down, and RIDE & HAVE FUN.

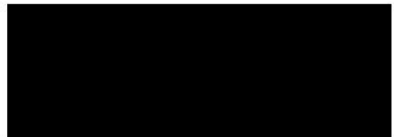


