## 2005 Officer Nominations

It's that time of the year again to start thinking about officers for the 2005 year.

In this month's newsletter you will find a form to fill out to nominate people for officer positions. You can nominate yourself or someone else to a position you think you (or they) can fulfill. Being an officer gives you the opportunity to meet new people and get to know them on a more personal basis. Some of the positions require a considerable commitment of your time and effort, but it is still the "fun factor" that entices people to commit for a year.

If you are interested in a position for next year, contact officers from previous years to get an understanding of what is required for a position, and if it is something you may be interested in.

Listed below is a summary of primary officer and discretionary officer positions and their duties. Remember that some of the duties cross over from one position to another. We are a "family" here, and we "share the load" to make sure no one has to work TOO hard.

### PRIMARY OFFICER POSITIONS

#### Director

Assumes overall responsibility for the administration of the chapter and implemen-

tation of policies. Conducts monthly meetings. Coordinates chapter officer responsibilities

#### Assistant Director

Assists the Director as requested in upholding the annual charter. Promotes National HOG programs and benefits. Enlists other officers to assist in various activities.

#### Treasurer

Collects chapter dues. Manages chapter funds. Reports financial transactions to members monthly. Submits the annual financial statement to National HOG by January 31. Maintains a running comparison of current year chapter finances with prior year for presentation at the annual meeting.

#### Secretary

Keeps minutes of all chapter meetings. Oversees the administrative needs of the chapter. Oversees membership officer position compliance to National HOG requirements. Submit forms as required to National HOG.

### DISCRETIONARY OFFICER POSITIONS

#### Activities Director

Scout locations and make initial contacts for upcoming events. Work with volunteers and Volunteer Coordinator. Work with Road Captains for upcoming events.

**Editor**

Publishes monthly newsletter and distributes by U.S. Mail or email as required. Send one copy to National HOG. Work with webmaster to submit material to chapter website. Enlist volunteers for articles and submissions to the newsletter and website.

**Membership**

Processes all Applications for Membership. High speed internet connection preferred for checking National HOG membership status and input to National HOG Member list. Also keeps separate database on Microsoft Works 6.0 for local use. Handles all membership inquiries. Provides membership address and email list to Editor for Newsletter distribution. Distributes membership lists as required.

**Road Captain**

Educates chapter members on group riding and hand signals. Coordinates road guards for activities as needed.. Assist in planning ride routes. Hold monthly Road Captain meetings. Organize monthly RiderZone riding techniques classes for members.

**Road Guards**

Assist Road Captain as needed. Lead group rides as directed by Road Captain. Help planning ride routes. Attend monthly Road Captain meetings and/or training sessions.

**Safety Officer**

Educates members on safe riding techniques.

**Photographers**

Take photos at El Cajon HOG events/activities and submit to Webmaster to put on EC HOG website.

**Webmaster/Historian**

Update all information on El Cajon HOG website, including "Members Only" section, photographs, calendars, etc. Send out all mass emails to members. Keep submitted photos in book for review by others.

I have been doing the HOG Newsletter for 3 years and have had a lot of fun doing it. I want to thank all of you for the great articles you've submitted. I also have been involved with processing membership applications and doing the computer input for the membership database. I have decided to give up these positions in 2005 and let someone else have the opportunity to be an officer. This past year Robert Stoner has also been involved in the membership process so he can answer any membership questions also.

## First Rider Zone Extravaganza by David Rosenberg

**L**ast month El Cajon HOG held its first "Rider Zone Extravaganza" riding skills course. We had 50 members show up and learn to ride their bikes like they never have before. No we weren't zipping around the race course dragging body parts at 100 plus miles an hour with our hair on fire. In fact, the action was slow, but somehow just as exciting.

This program was initiated by Howard Kendall, the club's Safety Officer. As an officer in the San Diego PD for approximately thirty years, Howard was well aware of these skills and how valuable they are. After all, Motor Officers have been learning these skills for decades, if they are good enough for professional riders, they are good enough for us.

Mike Scott helped us secure the use of the El Cajon Elk's Club's parking lot. Originally we used the larger west lot, but due to noise complaints we were asked to move to the east lot. For some reason the residence of the condo's next to the Elk's didn't like the sound of our 88 cubic inch V-twins early in the morning, go figure. After putting ourselves through the program twice we decided we were ready to bring it to the membership.

As the day approached, we didn't know what kind of response we would get from the membership. Rider Zone meetings generally have a turn out of about 25 people. Mostly new members who want to learn how we ride in a group with a few regulars who just like to hone their skills. For this, we thought we could have either five or fifty riders, we just didn't know. You can imagine our surprise when we arrived at the club house at 8:30 and we already had a handful of people waiting. By 9:00 we were standing room only.

The program started with a brief introduction and then we watched "Ride Like a Pro III" an entertaining 35 minute video by Jerry "Motorman" Palladino. Jerry is a retired FL motor officer who produced a video on the very skills we were teaching (you can buy this video from his web site <http://www.ridelikeapro.com>). This was followed by a short safety brief and then we rode over to the Elks.

You can imagine the surprise of the other Road Captains at the Elks when we pulled in to the parking lot with over 50 bikes. Robert Stoner quickly took control, we divided into groups and started the training. I won't go into detail about the training. I think it was eye opening to everyone how slow you can ride your bike and still be in control. With so many people it was a challenge to get everyone through the exercises quickly. We worked

until 12:30 then broke for lunch. \$2 bought you the best burger and beans in So Cal, thanks to your local Elks. After lunch the crowd thinned out a bit. Many people couldn't stay but those who did got some more practice. By two o'clock, everyone who wanted to, had learned the skills.

None of this would have been possible without a lot of hard work on the part of your Road Captains, Howard Kendall, Robert Stoner, Mike "Mongo" Heyd, Ron "Rookie" Straight, Kyle Krall, Joe Lacombe and Kathleen McManus.

If you missed out, don't worry, we will do it again.


